Despite the numerous well-recognized benefits of participation in sport, evidence indicates that interpersonal violence (harassment and abuse) occurs in all sports and at all levels. Creating a safe sport environment and safeguarding rowers and other participants in Rowing activities and events is a shared duty and responsibility of everybody who is involved in the sports ecosystem, this includes during events. You can play a crucial role in preventing interpersonal violence (harassment and abuse) from happening in your team/surroundings, as well as recognize, identify, and report when an athlete or other individual needs help or support.

From 07:15 until 20 minutes prior to the first race and 20 minutes after the last race until 18:30 hrs. Training during the lunch break is allowed 20 minutes after the last race of morning session up to 20 minutes before the start of the first race of afternoon session.

Control Commission

The Control Commission is located at the on the shore beside the outgoing pontoon and the incoming pontoon. The Control Commission will be present during all times the venue is officially open.

Country Code Stickers

For safety reasons crews will be required to have their country code stickers on the boats before being allowed onto the water, both for training and racing. OC volunteers or NTOs will assist the crews to fix the stickers on the boats. Please plan for sufficient time for the fixing of the stickers before the first training session.





Blades Identification

As described in the World Rowing Rules, from the time the venue is officially open for training, the teams are required to ensure that all blades are painted in Member Federation colors before going on the water.

Bow Numbers

Bow numbers will be distributed to crews on the outgoing pontoon and will be collected again at the incoming pontoon.

GPS Devices

All boats must be fitted with a “base plate” to hold the GPS timing devices. These plates will be fixed to the boats by a team of OC volunteers and by Swiss Timing technicians on Monday, 20 July 2026, and Tuesday, 21 July 2026 in the boat weighing area. Please ensure they are in place before the first day of racing.

Advertising

Please check the World Rowing Rules of Racing and related Byelaws to ensure that your racing uniforms and boats comply with the advertising rules.

Boat Weighing

Boat weighing will take place in Boathouse no 10. Test scales will be available from Monday, 20 July 2026, and will remain open during venue opening hours, except for racing times.

Athlete Weighing

Athlete weighing will take place in the Athletes Rest Area on the first floor above Boathouse no. 1 – 6. Test scales will be available from Monday, 20 July 2026 and will remain open during the opening hours of the venue.





Boat Storage

The boat racks are situated in the boathouse area. The Organizing Committee will assign boat racks for all boats.

Teams are responsible to make sure that their boats are always safely tied to the racks and are at no risk to being damaged in case of adverse weather conditions.

Pontoons

There is one outgoing and one incoming pontoon.

Boat Repair

The Boat Repair Services are located in the boathouse area.

Boat Washing

No chemical detergents or other sources of environmental pollutants should be used to wash boats. The boat washing area is in the boathouse area behind the Boat Weighing boathouse no. 10.

Ergometers

Ergometers are provided in the tent next to the team tent area behind the finish tower.

Changing Rooms

The changing rooms are situated above the hangars no. 1 – 6.

Sanitary Facilities & Toilets

There are toilets and showers in the changing rooms above the hangars as well as in the athlete area next to the Catering tent.

Bag Storage

Bag drop-off will be a secure area in front of the regatta office building. It will be open from 7:00 to 21:30. Bag storage will be operated digitally. Accreditation cards will be used to save your bag-tag.





Rest Area

The dedicated rest area will be on the first floor above the hangars no. 1 – 6.

National teams' tents can be set up in the team tent area behind the finish tower.

Nations who want to bring their own tent from the Organizing Committee must submit this request via the Team Tent Request on our website (<https://duisburg2026.com/team-tent-request/>).

Spectator Area for Athletes

Races can be followed on the World Rowing Tracker and from the Boathouse area. All races will be live streamed via <https://worldrowing.com> and on the big screen at the venue.

Accreditation provides access to the standing room area in front of the spectator's grandstand.

Cycling During Training and Racing

During training and racing, coaches can cycle along the course, but they must remain aware of their surroundings, as the paths around the course are open to the public. Coaches are asked to stay on the eastern side of the venue.

The OC provides a limited number of bikes for free short-term rental. They can be exchanged with the personal accreditation badge in the boat storage area.

Doping Control

The Doping Control Test Centre is located above the hangars. All doping control tests will be conducted in accordance with WADA and World Rowing requirements by the International Testing Agency (ITA). For all information about the doping control and procedures, please refer to the World Anti-Doping Code and International Standards available on the website www.wada-ama.org and the World Rowing Anti-Doping Bye Laws. Further information is available on the World Rowing website www.worldrowing.com.

Please be reminded that in case of doping controls, your athletes will be required to have a photo identification with them at the venue.

The transportation office is located in the Regatta Office Building and can be contacted by the Info Desk.

Transportation is only free of charge for the teams who booked accommodation through the Organizing Committee (OC).

The following services are provided to teams who booked accommodation through the OC:

1. Bus transfer between Düsseldorf International Airport or Duisburg Central Train station and their hotels or the venue upon arrival and departure.
2. Bus transfers from their hotels to the venue and back during the event.

Bookings for these services can be made the following way:

Airport Shuttle	All teams are requested to share their airport transport requirements with the OC via the Airport Shuttle Request (https://duisburg2026.com/teams/transport/airport-shuttle-request/)
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Venue Shuttle	There is a continuous venue shuttle connecting the OC partner hotels and the venue. Teams do not need to book a specific transportation time for the venue shuttle.
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Train Station	The train station is connected via the Venue Shuttle as multiple OC partner hotels are located in the train station area.
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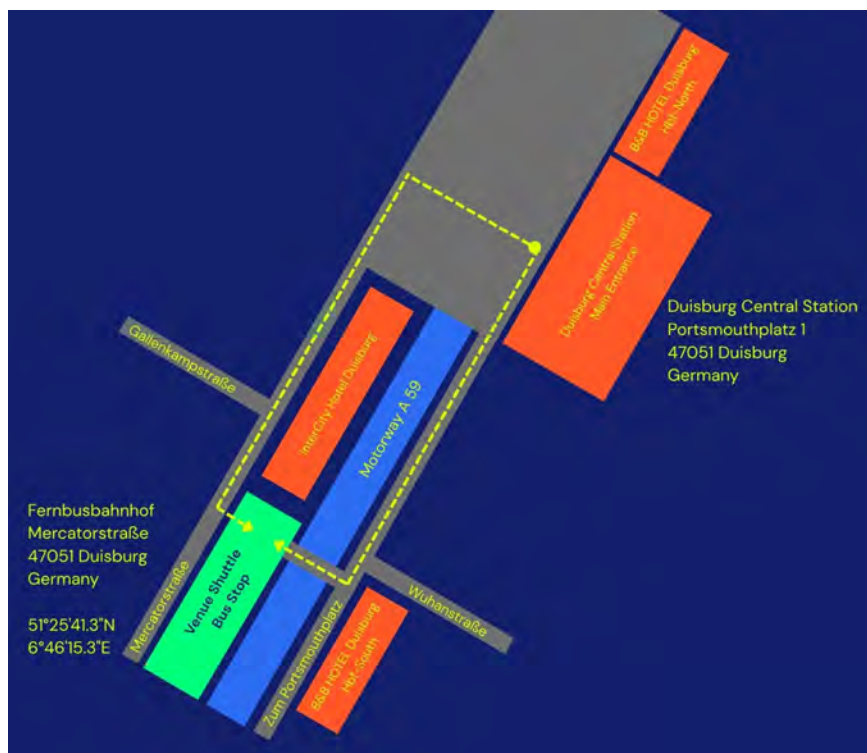


Arrival at Düsseldorf International Airport

Teams arriving at the Düsseldorf International Airport will be welcomed by a OC volunteers who will guide them to their airport shuttles. You will find your OC volunteers at the exit of your respective baggage carousel upon your arrival. The OC volunteers will wear orange "Volunteer" shirts and have a sign with the event logo.

Arrival at Duisburg Central Station

Teams arriving at Duisburg Central Station are asked to proceed individually to the venue shuttle to drive to the regatta venue. Therefore, please exit the central station at the main entrance and then process to the venue shuttle bus stop according to the below map.





Venue Shuttle

Busess will wait at the respective venue shuttle pickup points in front of the OC partner hotels. To get from the venue to the hotel, you can get on to the bus at the athlete bus drop-off point.

The official transport service will operate from Saturday, 18 July 2026 until Sunday, 26 July 2026. Transportation before these dates is available upon request.

Transport services will operate on the official event days (Monday to Sunday) from 06:45 to 21:30 and from 10:00 to 21:30 on the arrival weekend (18/19 July) with additional transport capacity in peak times in the morning and evening.

Please be aware that there are multiple bus lines to connect the various hotels. The latest shuttle plan will be published on our website www.duisburg2026.com.

Team Cars and Parking

Due to limited parking space, teams are kindly asked to use the official transportation service provided by the Organizing Committee.

A limited parking space is available which requires an obligatory parking pass that can be requested at the Accreditation Center.

Parking space for team coach buses is available in front of the „Schauinsland-Reisen Arena“. Please be aware that there is an American Football match in the afternoon of Saturday, 18 July, which can further limit the available parking space.

Boat Transport and Trailer Parking

From Saturday to Tuesday (18 – 21 July) trailers can be unloaded in the boathouse area. Please enter *Kruppstraße 30A, 47055 Duisburg* as your destination in your navigation system for access to the boat storage area. Please send us your estimated time of arrival using this form or forward its link to your driver: <https://duisburg2026.com/teams/transport/trailer-arrival-form/>. You can also Call/WhatsApp/Message Moritz Pilaski (+49 1520 7905606) to let our team know your estimated arrival time.

After your team has unloaded your boats at the boathouse, the trailers must immediately be moved to the [trailer parking lot \(P3\)](#) next to the Schauinsland-Reisen Arena. After that time, trailers will only be allowed back in the boathouse area on Sunday, 26 July, approximately half an hour after the final race.

General Information

Teams that have booked their accommodation through the OC will reside at selected hotels on a full board basis. Breakfast is provided at your accommodations, lunch and dinner will be provided at the venue. Catering Tent

Please note that tap water in Germany is drinkable and of a high quality. There will be multiple water refill stations to fill reusable water bottles. The OC will provide sustainable water bottles to all athletes. The team managers will receive respective vouchers in the accreditation center upon first arrival that can be used to get those bottles at the bag drop. Please help us to reduce single-use plastics and garbage.

Crew Changes

On arrival, Team Managers are requested to check their crew entries at the Accreditation Centre. In case of any changes in the crew composition, seating order, or spelling of the names, they must complete the Crew Change Form and submit it to Ela Žuvanić at the World Rowing registration desk at the Regatta Venue no later than 12:00hrs on Wednesday, 22 July 2026 (3 hours before the Draw).

For medical substitutions and withdrawals after the draw, please see the World Rowing Doctor at the World Rowing office, followed by submission of the crew change form.

All rowers must read and sign the World Rowing Commitment form & WADA Consent form. The signed forms must be uploaded to the athlete's profile by Wednesday, 22 July, 12:00 hrs. Hard copies do not need to be submitted.

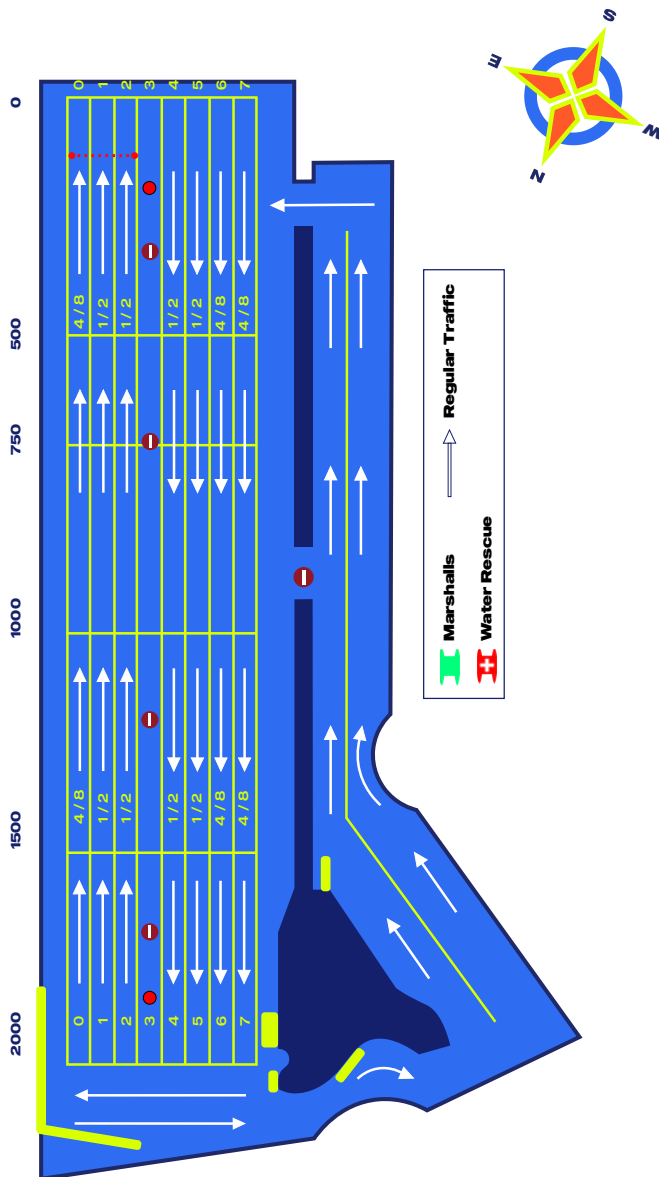

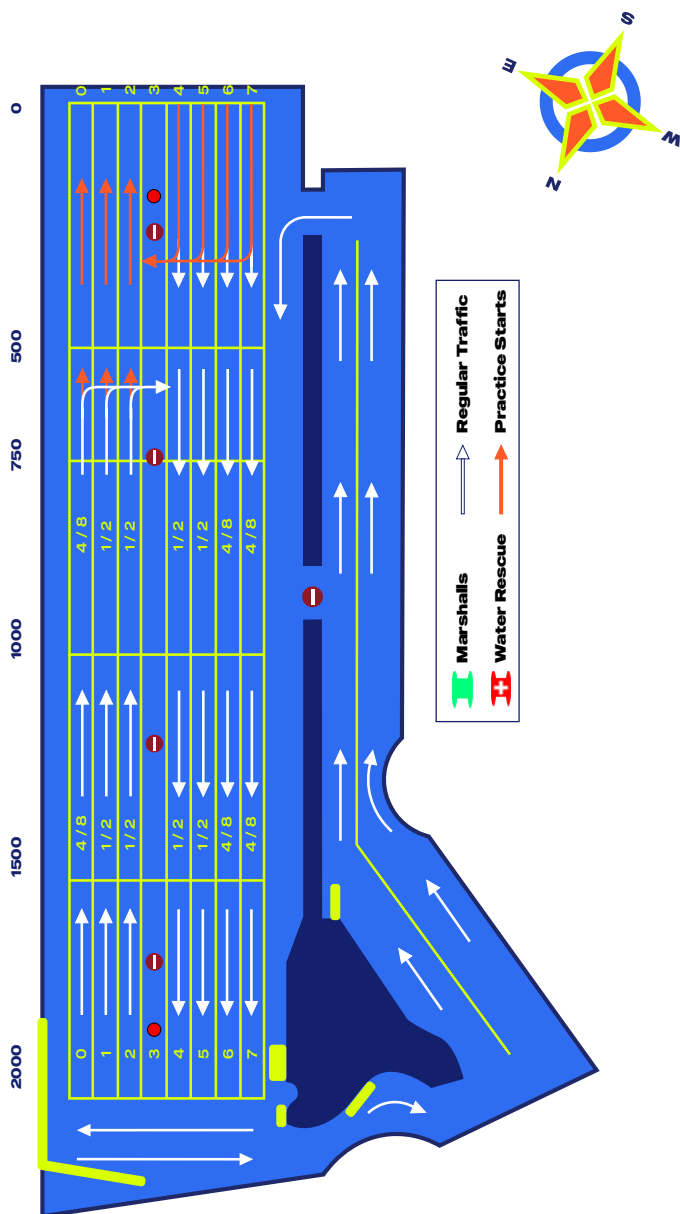

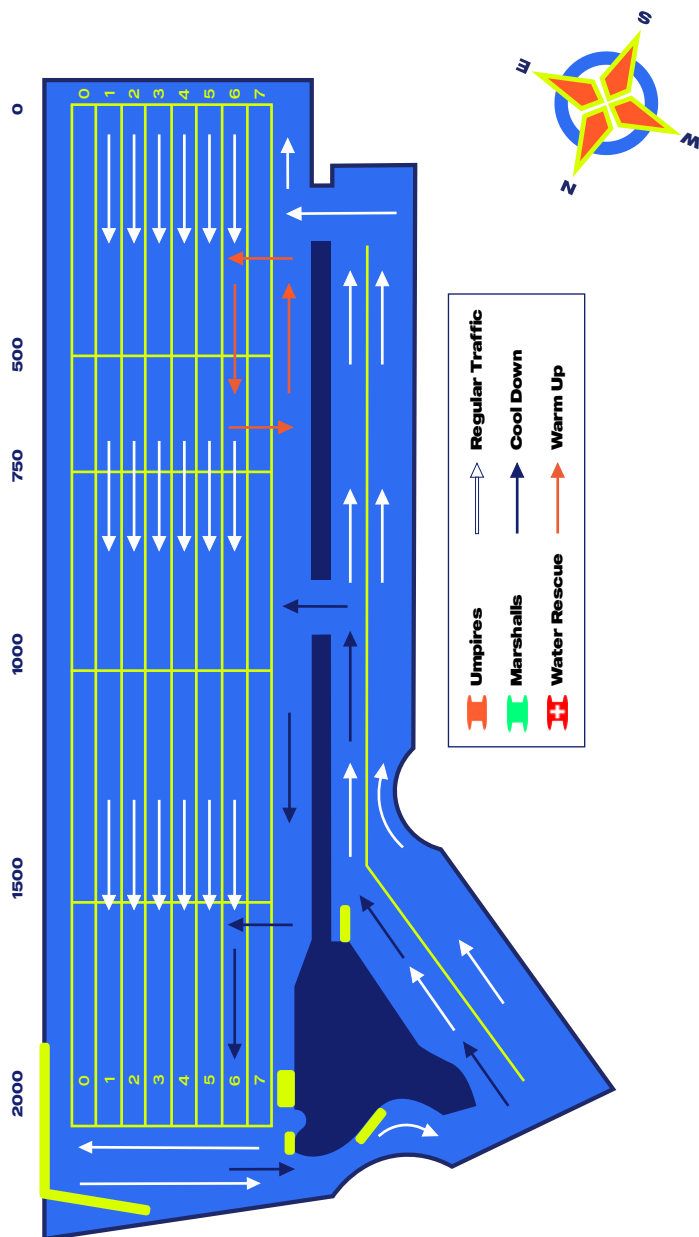


Traffic Rules Practice Starts
